

How to retrieve a database from the Toolbox FTP site (Single user)

Retrieving from the FTP site

Right click on the Windows "Start" button.

- Select "Explore all Users"

- Type ftp.toolboxsoftware.com into the Address bar, without the quotes.

- If there is no Address bar, click on "View" at the top of the window.

- Select Toolbars.

- Ensure that the "Address Bar" is checked, and that "Lock The Toolbars" is unchecked.

- You may now resize the Address bar.

- A login window will pop up asking for a username and password.

- Contact Toolbox for your company's username and password

- Double click on the Updates folder

- Double click on the Users folder

- Double click on the folder associated with your company.

- Drag and drop the zipped database from the folder onto your desktop.

- Once the transfer is finished, close the window.

Extracting the database and the log file

Double click on the zipped database on your desktop.

- A window will open up that shows the files contained within the zip file. There should be a .db file and a .log file. Leave this window open.

- Click on the Windows "Start" button and select "My Computer"

- Double click on the C drive

- Double click on the Toolbox folder

- Double click on the Database folder

- Drag and drop the .db file and the .log file into the C:\Toolbox\database folder that you just opened.

Setting the database up in the ODBC administrator

Click on the Windows "Start" button

- Select Programs

- Find Toolbox in the list of programs

- Select ODBC

- When the ODBC Administrator window opens up, click on the "Add" button

- Another window will open. Select "Adaptive Server Anywhere 9" out of the list of drivers. Then click "Finish".

- Another window will open up. Enter the company name as the "Data Source Name".

- Click on the Login tab at the top of the window. Enter the following information:

 - User ID: supersoft

 - Password: 1zzz2202

- Click on the Database tab at the top of the window.

 - Enter the server name as "toolbox" without the quotes.

- Type "C:\Program Files\ASA\win32\dbeng9.exe" (without the quotes) into the "Start In" line

- Click the "Browse" button below the Database File line, and browse for the database file on your C: Drive. It should be in the C:\Toolbox\database\ folder.

 - Click the "OK" button at the bottom of the window.
